New Business:

-Analyze CAASPP Results Data

M. Garza reviewed the California Assessment of Student Performance and Progress (CAASPP) Data with SSC and the developed three conclusions per data section that will be included in next year's site plan.

-SPSA End of Year Annual Evaluation

SSC reviewed strategies and actions steps that were fully implemented, partially implemented, and not fully implemented. Although our school has been doing a great job communicating electronically with parents through the Week At A Glance (WAAG) and the, monthly school newsletter, Crusader Times, SSC discussed ways that we could make our school more welcoming and inviting to parents. A. Bienes mentioned how some parents want to be more involved, but dates for PTSA general meetings were never communicated. Y. Williams-Lewis gave some ideas on how we could make our Parent Center more active for parents. M. Garza mentioned that she would take all their input into account in the development of next year's site plan.

She mentioned how the Chief Financial Officer, Vernon Moore, presented the Complaints Procedure to parents. He explained the process and protocol for all filed complaints and reiterated that complaints could be completed in any language. M. Garza also stated that a speaker gave a presentation on the topic of immigration and that Chula Vista High School is hosting parent workshops in Spanish beginning April 3rd-May 22nd on a variety of topics. Our DPAC Representative, D. Gerken, mentioned that a DPAC Meeting had not been held since our last SSC Meeting, but that their next DPAC Meeting would take place after spring break and cover the topic of safety.

Public Comments: S. Hernandez asked why some schools require students to wear uniforms, but not others? She mentioned that her friend who attended a middle school that required uniforms stated that it had cut down the number of bullying incidents that took place. A. Bienes mentioned that she was part of a school where parents had voted for their school to adopt a uniform policy.
