IV. New Business:

-LCAP Goal 1 Feedback

-2017-18 SPSA Draft

- Title I Carryover Plan (Action)

M. Garza stated the Title I Carryover funds would be utilized to provide credit recovery to our Title I Cohort students who were deficit in credits. Motion for approval given by L. Pettay and was seconded by A. Coogan. SSC approved the Title I Carryover Plan as outlined in our 2017-18 SPSA Draft.
