New Business:

-Approval of Revised Single Plan for Student Achievement (Action)
 SSC reviewed the SPSA and discussed the updated data in the Data and Analysis section. SSC members highlighted the differences in math and English SBAC results amongst grade levels. M. Amador mentioned the summary of differences between the Action Steps from May 2016 and the current Action Steps listed in the site plan. Motion for approval given by D. Gerken and was seconded by J. Stell. SSC approved the Revised SPSA.

- Approval of Parent Policy and School Compact (Action)
 SSC reviewed the Parent Policy and asked for the addition of Infinite Campus as a method of communication. SSC also requested an additional bullet under the parent section that strongly encourages parents to be active participants of their student’s academic success. Motion for approval given by G. Romo and was seconded by C. Lopez. SSC approved the Parent Policy and School Compact.

-Advisory Committee Reports

She also mentioned that they looked over LCAP Goal 3 and provided their feedback to the district. Our DPAC Representative, D. Gerken, provided an overview of some of the topics discussed at the meeting which varied from Title I Advantages, the importance of lunch applications, the revised CIS duty statement, and providing feedback on the Hanover Parent Survey. She also mentioned that they looked over LCAP Goal 3 and provided their feedback to the district.
