What is the School Site Council?

The School Site Council is a team comprised of the site principal, teachers, other personnel, students, and parents. They are charged with the following responsibilities:

- Developing a quality school improvement plan.
- Allocating supplemental resources (monies from the state which supplement the educational needs of specifically identified students).
- Annually reviewing and updating the school site plan, safety plan and Categorical budgets to meet changing needs for approval by the Board of Education.

The School Site Council meets once a month.

How Can You Become a School Site Council Member?

Interested candidates need to complete the reverse side of this flyer. Please provide your name, address, phone number, name and grade of your child, and a brief, one paragraph autobiographical sketch. Many candidates include prior experience and involvement with school service. Experience is not a requirement; your desire and commitment are all you need. This sketch will be published on the ballot to assist all the parent voters in making their choices. Elections will be held at Back to School Night, Thursday, August 13, 2015. The voting will take place during the advisory period that evening. Parents will be electing two members and one alternate to complete the team who will be serving a two-year term.
