IV. New Business:

-LCAP Goal 2 Update: School Culture and Climate

T. Kramer discussed that this has been identified as an area of need by all stakeholders and the topic is currently being led by the Site Curriculum Specialists in Staff Development Meetings with the goal of establishing the "Crusader Way". Once those characteristics have been set, staff can help support and recognize that specific behavior whenever it is demonstrated by students. SSC discussed the possibility of modifying our school mascot to be more inclusive of individual's differences. M. Garza mentioned that she would be bringing Needs Assessment Data for SSC to analyze at our next SSC Meeting which included the results of our recent Hanover Survey. SSC requested that a student survey be included as part of the Needs Assessment Data. SSC also discussed the possibility of bringing in a consultant to present to parents like Tyler Durnam did for Eastlake Middle Last year.

V. Advisory Committee Reports

Our DPAC Representative, M. Herbst, was not able to attend the last DPAC Meeting, but plans to provide a DPAC Advisory Committee Report at our next SSC Meeting. Our DELAC
